



SFID Mandatory Water Use Restrictions for Residential Customers

- ✓ During the months of **June through October**, limit residential landscape irrigation to no more than *3 assigned days a week*.
 - Addresses ending with **even** numbers are allowed to irrigate
 - Saturday, Monday & Wednesday.
 - Addresses ending with **odd** numbers are allowed to irrigate
 - Sunday, Tuesday & Thursday.
 - Apartments & Condominiums are allowed to irrigate
 - Monday, Wednesday & Friday.
- ✓ During the months of **November through May**, landscape irrigation is limited to no more than *once per week*.
 - Addresses ending with **even** numbers are allowed to irrigate on Tuesday.
 - Addresses ending with **odd** numbers are allowed to irrigate on Thursday.
 - Apartments and Condominiums are allowed to irrigate on Wednesday.
- ✓ Irrigate landscape **before 8 a.m. and after 6 p.m.** on your assigned day.
- ✓ Limit lawn watering and landscape irrigation, using sprinklers, to no more than ten (10) minutes per watering station per assigned day. This provision does not apply to landscape irrigation systems using water-efficient devices, including but not limited to: weather-based controllers, drip/micro-irrigation systems, and stream rotor sprinklers.
- ✓ Stop water waste resulting from inefficient landscape irrigation, such as runoff, overspray, or broken sprinkler heads, etc. Similarly, stop water flows onto non-targeted areas, such as adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, hardscapes, roadways, or structures.
- ✓ Stop washing down paved surfaces, including but not limited to sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, or patios, except when it is necessary to alleviate safety or sanitation hazards.
- ✓ Use a hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle or bucket to water landscaped areas, including trees and shrubs located on the property that are not irrigated by a landscape irrigation system.
- ✓ Watering of livestock is permitted at any time.
- ✓ Wash vehicles using a bucket and hand-held hose with positive shut-off nozzle, mobile high pressure/low volume wash system, or at a commercial site that re-circulates (reclaims) water on-site. Avoid washing during hot conditions when additional water is required due to evaporation.
- ✓ Stop operating ornamental fountains or similar decorative water features unless recycled water is used.
- ✓ Repair all water leaks within 72 hours of notification by the Santa Fe Irrigation District unless other arrangements are made with the General Manager.



SFID Mandatory Water Use Restrictions for Commercial Customers

- ✓ During the months of **June through October**, limit landscape irrigation to no more than *3 assigned days a week*. Businesses are allowed to irrigate Monday, Wednesday and Friday. This does not apply to commercial growers or nurseries.
- ✓ During the months of **November through May**, limit landscape irrigation to no more than *once per week*. Businesses are allowed to irrigate on Wednesday. This does not apply to commercial growers or nurseries.
- ✓ Limit lawn watering and landscape irrigation, using sprinklers, to no more than ten (10) minutes per watering station, per assigned day. This provision does not apply to landscape irrigation systems using water-efficient devices, including but not limited to: weather-based controllers, drip/micro-irrigation systems, and stream rotor sprinklers.
- ✓ Irrigate business landscape **before 8 a.m. and after 6 p.m.** on your assigned day.
- ✓ Irrigate nursery and commercial grower's products before **10 a.m. and after 6 p.m.** only. Watering is permitted at any time with a hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle, a bucket, or when a drip/micro-irrigation system/equipment is used. Irrigation of a nursery propagation bed is permitted at any time.
- ✓ Watering of livestock is permitted at any time.
- ✓ Use a hand-held hose equipped with a positive shut-off nozzle or bucket to water landscaped areas, including trees and shrubs located on commercial properties that are not irrigated by a landscape irrigation system.
- ✓ Stop water waste resulting from inefficient landscape irrigation, such as run-off, broken sprinkler heads, or overspray, etc. Similarly, stop water flows onto non-targeted areas, such as adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, hardscapes, roadways, or structures.
- ✓ Stop washing down paved surfaces, including but not limited to sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, tennis courts, or patios, except when it is necessary to alleviate safety or sanitation hazards.
- ✓ Stop operating ornamental fountains or similar decorative water features unless recycled water is used.
- ✓ Repair all water leaks within 72 hours of notification by the Santa Fe Irrigation District unless other arrangements are made with the General Manager.
- ✓ Use recycled or non-potable water for construction purposes when available.
- ✓ Serve and refill water in restaurants and other food service establishments only upon request.
- ✓ Offer guests in hotels, motels, and other commercial lodging establishments the option of not laundering towels and linens daily.
